The 2020 Annual Camphill Research Symposium is offered 100 % virtually this year!

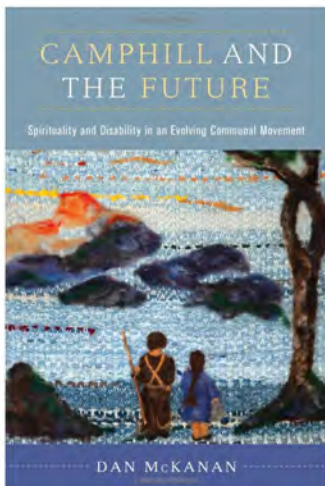
